Section 12.150 Whenever an elective Office shall become vacant, or no person is nominated The Exalted Rule shall, not later than the second regular meeting, order an election to fill the vacancy . . . the Exalted Ruler may, at any time he deems expedient or necessary, appoint any Member, in good standing of the Lodge to fill the vacancy such appointee to have full power and authority. Whenever the number of the Trustees of the Lodge . . . Elections to fill vacancies arising in the preceding paragraph shall take place at the next regular meeting after said order. Nominations for Office may be made at the meeting when the Exalter Ruler orders the election and again at the meeting when the election is held The vacancy. . . May be filled at the same meeting. The voting procedure to fill a vacancy shall be governed by §3.090.
