July 28, 1940 Cost of car \$750.00 July 28, 1940 Annual clambake at Fair Grounds. Tickets \$2.00. Clams, Chicken, Potatoes, Sweet corn, Lobster & all the fixings that go into a fine bake.

A 1940 Pontiac Six automobile to be given away. Tickets \$1.00 book of five, or .25 cents each

Oct. 1944 ER Leo Conway called on Bro. Charles Walsh for a few remarks during initiation. Being a man of few words he stated that his number is 17.

March 1945 "Resolved" That upon news of the unconditional surrender of Germany, our Home & all departments thereof shall be closed for a period of 24 hours, during which no activities of any kind will be permitted.

Jan 1953 E.R. Charlie Gaudry announces plans for the 40th Anniversary celebration to be held at the Weldon Hotel Jan 31. Price \$3.00 Banquet, Dress optional.
