Aug. 13, 1939..A 1939 Packard Sedan will be awarded at the annual bake. Tickets 5 for \$1 or .25 ea.

March 23, 2016. Mrs. Joseph Sindut passed away at 103 years of age. She spent all her life in Greenfield with several positions of employment. Ten years at Millers Falls Tool Co. where her husband was a foreman. A highlight of her years was winning a 1939 Packard Sedan from Greenfield Elks clam bake when she purchased a .25 cent chance. May 1948..Letter from Rev. Father James

Hastings of St. Mary's in Turners Falls regarding a lot that has been neglected for some years, Bro. john McDonough's family having all died off and no one to care for the lot. Suggest that the elks take responsibility.

June 1948.. Motion to donate \$35.00 to T.F. band and G.H.S. band for their uniform fund in appreciation of their services on Flag Day. So voted




