In case you didn't know:

The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks have a long tradition of helping America's Veterans, dating back to World War I when the Elks bought equipment and paid the costs for Field Hospital No. 41 and No.46, the first two American Field Hospitals of their kind.

Shortly Afterwards, the great battles of the Western Front in 1918 sent an unending stream of maimed and wounded soldiers flowing back to the United States. The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Financed and built a 700bed Reconstruction Hospital for the Government. After the War they turned the Hospital over to the War Department and it became the first Veterans Hospital.

Also after WWI the Elks established the First G.I. Bill, when it established a fund that loaned money to returning veterans for vocational education. Ever Since the Elks have promised "That as long as there is a disabled veteran in our Hospitals, the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks will never forget them".
