ELKS SCHOLARSHIP, INC- applications available from school counselors, MAY NOT BE DUPLICATED. If more are needed contact <u>m.esi@verizon.net</u>. RETURN-ELKS LODGE 1296 no later than Feb. 1, 2018. MASSACHUSETTS ELKS VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP- available from school counselor, no photo copies. Available to individuals attending a vocational/technical school, junior college, or a community college working on a one or two year program of studies that will further his/her education culminating in an associates degree, diploma or semester credit hours each term. No age limit, must be a US citizen. Grant is for one year, applicant may reapply for a second year. Return to Elks Lodge no later than March 1, 2018.
