The Massachusetts Elks Lodges are having two Motorcycle Run Fundraisers this year to raise money for one of our state projects, "Massachusetts Elks Veterans Fund." One of the runs will be held at the *Billerica Elks Lodge on Sunday, September 16, 2018* and a second will be held at the *Middleboro Elks Lodge on Saturday, September 29, 2018*. Each year Elks Lodges throughout the state have fundraisers to raise money for hospitalized veterans.
