House Rules

- 1. A MEMBERS DUES MUST BE PAID UP TO HAVE CLUB PRIVILEGES. A MEMBER MAY BE CHALLENGED FOR PROOF OF DUES.
- 2. A VOTED UPON AND ACCEPTED PROSPECTIVE MEMBER WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CLUB WITH HIS SPONSOR.
- 3. A RESIDENT OF THE GREENFIELD LODGE 1296 GEOGRAPHICAL AREA, NOT AN ELK, TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, WILL BE ALLOWED TWO (2) VISITS TO THE CLUB AS A GUEST PER YEAR, EXCEPT FOR MEMBER-GUEST AND PUBLIC EVENTS SPONSORED BY THE CLUB AND LADIES ACCOMPANIED BY MEMBERS. ALL GUESTS AND ACCOMPANIED MEMBER(S) MUST SIGN THE GUEST BOOK.
- 4. ALL PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN(18) MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A MEMBER & WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE CLUB UNTIL 7:00 PM OR FOR SPECIAL OCCASIONS WHERE PREVIOUSLY ANNOUNCED OR POSTED.
- 5. PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN(18) ARE NOT PERMITTED AT THE BAR.
- 6. WOMEN GUESTS ARE PERMITTED AT THE BAR.
- 7. VISITING MEMBERS WILL BE AFFORDED ALL THE CLUB PRIVILEGES ONCE THEY HAVE SIGNED THE GUEST BOOK.
- 8. ALL MEMBERS & THEIR GUESTS WILL CONDUCT THEMSELVES IN A COURTEOUS AND ORDERLY MANNER. WATCH YOUR LANGUAGE,. EXCESSIVE FOUL OR ABUSIVE LANGUAGE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. MEMBERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR GUESTS, AND ARE REQUIRED TO REMAIN WITH THEM WHILE IN THE CLUB.
- 9. FIGHTING IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE CLUB.
- 10. IF, IN THE OPINION OF THE BARTENDER OR STEWARD, ANY PERSON IS ABUSING THE PRIVILEGES OF THE CLUB OR THE RIGHTS OF A MEMBER, THEY SHALL BE REFUSED ALL SERVICE & ASKED TO LEAVE. ANY PERSON "SHUT OFF" BY THE BARTENDER, FOR OVER-INDULGENCE OR FOR ANY OTHER REASON, SHALL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.
- 11. THE "BARTENDER" HAS THE FINAL SAY. ARGUING WITH OR ABUSING THE BARTENDER WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
- 12. LAST CALL SHALL BE GIVEN AT LEAST FIFTEEN (15) MINUTES BEFORE THE LEGALLY PRESCRIBED CLOSING TIME POSTED. ALL GLASSES & BOTTLES SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE BAR AND TABLES BY TEN(10) MINUTES PAST THE CLOSING TIME. NO MEMBER OR GUEST SHALL BE ALLOWED TO REMAIN ON THE PREMISES AFTER TWENTY (20) MINUTES PAST THE CLOSING TIME, EXCEPT THE BARTENDER(S) AND/OR PERSONS DULY EMPLOYED BY THE CLUB SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CLEANING OR CLOSING THE CLUB. NO ALCHOLIC BEVERAGES WILL BE CONSUMED DURING THIS CLOSING & CLEANUP TIME. ALL PERSONS WILL BE OUT OF THE BUILDING NO LATER THAN 2:00 AM.
- 13. NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED BEHIND THE BAR UNLESS ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS AND/OR WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE BARTENDER AND/OR THE MANAGER.
- 14. ALL ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (TV-VCR-RADIO-DVD ETC.) ARE UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE BARTENDER. ALL ADJUSTMENTS WILL BE AT THE DIRECTION OF THE BARTENDER OR THE MANAGER.
- 15. ALL PROPERTY OF THE LODGE/CLUB WILL REMAIN IN THE CLUB, AND NOT REMOVED WITHOUT THE AUTHORIZATION OF THE TRUSTEES CHAIRMAN/DIRECTOR.
- 16. THE CLUB/LODGE ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOST OF PERSONAL ARTICLES/CLOTHING.
- 17. IN CASES OF MALICIOUS DAMAGE, DESTRUCTION OR DEFACEMENT OF LODGE/CLUB PROPERTY, THE PEOPLE RESPONSIBLE SHALL BE SUBJECT TO ACTION RECOMMENDED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
- 18. THE BAR WILL BE CLOSED AT THE BEGINNING OF LODGE MEETINGS, AND WILL REMAIN CLOSED UNTIL THE LODGE MEETING IS OVER.
- 19. CLUB STEWARD & BARTENDERS REPORT DIRECTLY TO THE CHAIRMAN OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS, TRUSTEES AND APPOINTED MANAGER.
- 20. ALL COMPLAINTS OR SUGGESTIONS RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE DIRECTORS OR THE CLUB, SHALL BE IN WRITING AND BROUGHT BEFORE THE NEXT MEETING.
- 21. THESE RULES WILL BE ENFORCED WITH STRICT IMPARTIALITY.
- 22. ANY MEMBER WHO EXHIBITS DELIBERATE DISREGARD OF THE HOUSE RULES MAY BE SUBJECT TO ACTIONS RECOMMENDED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS.
- 23. VIOLATIONS OF THE STATUTES, RULES AND BYLAWS OF THIS LODGE WHICH PERTAIN TO THE CLUB OR FOR CONDUCT UNBECOMING AN ELK, WILL BE PROCESSED ACCORDING
