"On June 14, 1777, the Second continental congress took a break from writing the <u>Articles of Confederation</u> and passed a resolution stating that "the flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white," and that "the union be 13 stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation."

In 1907, our Order officially observed Flag Day 9 years before it became nationally recognized by Congress. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson marked the anniversary by officially establishing June 14 as Flag Day.

"This June 14th, our lodge will celebrate Flag Day as required by the statutes of our order. We are also holding an initiation of new members. I invite our members, who have never seen our Flag Day ceremony, to join us. The ceremony starts at 6:00 pm. The initiation will take place at the lodge meeting."

As Elks, we've all heard our slogan; "Elks Share, Elks Care." Our members have over the years, done good things for our communities. We support our school children with the dictionary project and the book fair. We support our local scouting units. We do this with grants. The Grand Lodge has several grants that local lodges can apply for to put forward to any number of charitable opportunities.

The money available are broken down into several grants, each with a different aim: Beacon, Freedom, Gratitude, spotlight and Impact (for details on each grant, log onto Elks website). The amount of grant money each lodge can obtain is based on the generosity of membership to the Elks National foundation (or ENF). Each year the Grand Exalted Ruler sets goals for per member donations. This year the goal is \$4.80/member. If a lodge reaches that goal, for each dollar donated, the lodge can get \$3.00 back in grant money. Our lodge is currently at \$0.65/member.

You can make a donation by many different ways:1) You can log onto www.elks.org, find the link to "donate to Elks National Foundation", fill out the form and provide your credit card information; or 2) Reach out our Secretary Fred Ulrich for a donation form. There are forms at the bar where you can fill out and give to the bartender with whatever donation you wish to provide.

As Exalted Ruler, I'm asking each member to do two things; 1) please take the time to donate \$5.00 to the ENF so our lodge can help our communities; and 2) If you know of a need in our community, please bring it to our Board of directors. Gary Gadreault, PER and Trustee, works hard to write grant requests, but we need our members to help us identify a need. We can't obviously help everyone, but we can do our best to help. 
