Joint Committee on Revenue

Dear Chairman Moran and Cusack.

I hope this letter finds you and the members of the Joint Committee on Revenue doing well. I am writing in support of House Bill 2703, "An Act exempting certain fraternal organizations from the tax of sales of alcoholic beverages," sponsored by Representative Ayers.

This bill had its public hearing on Tuesday, September 12, 2023, before your committee. I would like to go on record in support of this bill. In my involvement with all the Massachusetts Elks Lodges, along with being the State Sponsor of 3 other states: New Hampshire, Maine, and Rhode Island, I see what a crucial role they play in the community, and the benefits of their charitable endeavors going back to those in need. I also understand the financial struggles that these organizations face in the wake of the COVID-19 pandemic and the lasting economic hardship it created.

With the passage of this legislation, it would help fraternal organizations like our own continue to perform and enhance the charitable endeavors and community development efforts we have practiced for many years, which are crucial in our mission to build and strengthen our local communities.

I have attached a Charitable Giving Report for the combined 55 lodges in Massachusetts along with an additional Charitable Giving Report for our Massachusetts State Association for the fraternal year ending 3/31/2023. As you can see the 55 lodges show the number of volunteers, hours spent, miles driven, and contributions totaling \$6,466,143.56 and the State Association shows the number of volunteers, hours spent, miles driven, and contributions totaling \$566,459.00 for a total of \$7,032,602.58 for the lodge year ending 3/31/2023.

Therefore, I would like to go on the record in support of H2703.
