April 6 – Army Day

Easter Sunday

Second Sunday in May – Mother's Day

Third Saturday in May – Armed Forces Day

The Last Monday in May – Memorial Day (half-staff until noon)

June 14 – Flag Day

July 4 – Independence Day

First Monday in September – Labor Day

September 17 – Citizenship Day

Second Monday in October – Columbus Day

October 27 – Navy Day

November 11 – Veterans' Day

Fourth Thursday in November – Thanksgiving Day

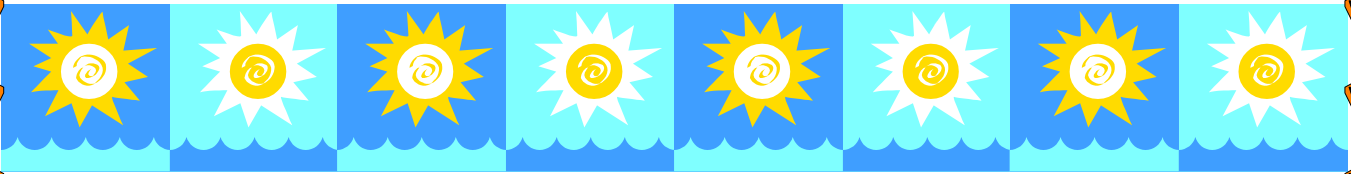
